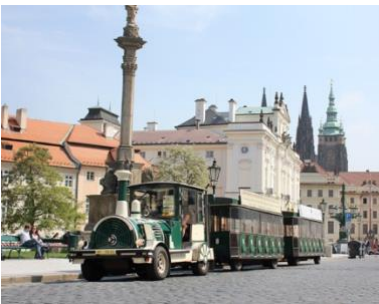


7 HILLS, 15 BRIDGES & 5 QUARTERS

Prague was built on seven hills. The Vltava River flows between them. Fifteen bridges connect the city. The center consists of five quarters, each with its own character:

- **Staré Mesto** (Old Town) with its windy, narrow streets.
- **Nové Mesto** (New Town), over 600 years old, with the popular Wenceslas Square.
- **Malá Strana** (Small Town) is the most picturesque part of Prague with its palaces
- **Hradcany**, the part around the well-known Castle of Prague and Vysehrad, named after the fortress on the rocks high above the Vltava.
- **Josefov**, the Jewish ghetto where the ghost of the most famous Czech writer, Franz Kafka still walks.

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
