PRAGUE

Prague doesn't really need an introduction; the beauty of the city has been legendary since the Middle Ages. The Czechs love their capital and have a big passion for the past. This is why the city is beautifully preserved and Prague works like a magnet to visitors from all over the world. They come for the fabulous architecture, numerous impressive monuments, charming alleys and lively shopping areas in a historical setting.

T HILLS, 15 BRIDGES & 5 QUARTERS

Prague was built on seven hills. The Vltava River flows between them. Fifteen bridges connect the city. The center consists of five quarters, each with its own character:

- Staré Mesto (Old Town) with its windy, narrow streets.
- Nové Mesto (New Town), over 600 years old, with the popular Wencelas Square.
- Malá Strana (Small Town) is the most picturesque part of Prague with its palaces
- Hradcany, the part around the well-known Castle of Prague and Vysehrad, named after the fortress on the rocks high above the Vltava.
- Josefov, the Jewish ghetto where the ghost of the most famous Czech writer, Franz Kafka still walks.
