KOLDING

KOLDINGHUS

Koldinghus was built in the middle of the 13th century, and in the centuries that followed it was one of Denmark's most important royal castles. In 1808 there was a fire that left the castle in ruins – a romantic relic. Today the castle has been restored and houses a museum which is a centre for cultural activities and special exhibitions of international standing.

LEGOLAND

Legoland is located approximately 50 kilometres from Kolding. The park with its famous toys is full of fast and exciting adventures. It is a place where children of all ages play, experiment and get ideas. It has knights in shining armour, pirates, wild cowboys, Indians and much more. And the nicest thing of all is that there is always something new and exciting in Legoland!



LEGE PARKEN

Close to Koldinghus, is the popular playground and park known as Legeparken. Legeparken is a recreational area for children and adults, and it is open all year round. The main attraction is a 5000 square meter artificial lake, featuring free rowing boats. You will also find assorted playground equipment, activity buildings and a kiosk.
