### **FIELDS**

The tournament takes place in the suburbs of Thessaloniki, in a facility with seven 11x11 size football natural grass fields.



### **REFEREES**

All games will be conducted by official referees.



### FIRST AID

All tournament matches will be played with the presence of doctors or persons who are official certified to provide first aid.



### LOGISTICS











The participants during their staying in Thessaloniki can choose between 2\*\*, 3\*\*\* and 4\*\*\*\* star hotels.

Players will be accommodated in triple and quad rooms while parents and coaches in doubles & singles.

All the above are subject of the group needs and the availability of the hotels.



Meals basic plan includes 3 meals per day (breakfast-lunch-dinner).

For those clubs who wish half board there is the option of two meals (breakfast-lunch or dinner)

All meals are served at the restaurant of the hotel or in nearby restaurants,

### **TRANSFERS**



Teams can use tournament shuttle service for their transfer to the fields or rent a private motor-coach for their own exclusive use during the tournament.

Transfers from/to airports or railway station can be arranged through the tournament organization at very low coast.



The famous symbol of Thessaloniki and one of the most recognizable monuments in Greece, the **WHITE TOWER** was built as a fortified tower in the 15th century and used as a military camp and prison. The last restoration was completed in 1985 and since then the White Tower is used for exhibitions, while from 2006 operates permanently as a museum of the city.



A great place to visit and find out about the Olympic spirit. Enjoy a wide range of exhibitions and sport-related events. The **OLYMPIC MUSEUM** has a fully equipped auditorium, 2multi-purpose rooms, a cafeteria and a gift shop.



The **UPPER CITY** is one of the few areas of Thessaloniki which survived after the devastating fire of 1917. Within the boundaries of the Upper City there are some of the most important monuments of the city such as Eptapyrgio, the church of Saint David, the Vlatadon Monastery and the Church of the Archangels.
