PELION MOUNTAIN

According to Greek mythology, Pelion was the summer residence of the Gods and the home of the Centaurs. The mountain offers to all visitors beautiful green landscapes, crystalline springs, golden sandy beaches with crystal clear waters, imposing peaks, over 70 picturesque villages built with the traditional Pelioreite Architecture, paved cobblestones, bridges, traditional mansions and neat, guesthouses. A 12 month destination for relaxation as well as adventure, since apart from the ski resort it has a dense network of hiking trails and coves with small or large beaches with sand or pebbles.

"MOUTZOURIS" STEAM TRAIN

One of the most famous attractions of the region of Magnesia is the Pelion steam train, also known as "Moutzouris". Its history starts at the beginning of the 20th century, connecting the city of Volos with Lechonia and a few years later the line was extended to Milies, a route of 29 kilometers. The name "Moutzouris" was taken from the steam engines that pulled the train carriages. In the approximately one and a half hour journey, "Moutzouris" passes through 11 big and many more smaller bridges until it reaches to its final destination, Milies.

• "ARGO"

"Argo" is the symbol of the city of Volos, a mythical ship widely known around the world, through the legend of the Aeronautic Expedition of Jason and the Argonauts in order to take the Golden Fleece from Colchis. It is described as the fastest and most solid vessel of its time. Today everybody has the chance to admire the modern version of "Argo", a revival work of myth in the port of the city. The ship was rebuilt in 2008 according to the methods and designs of the 13th century BC, by the shipbuilder Nikolaos Reppos.

CITY SEA FRONT

A reference point of Volos is the city water front, with its fishermen and fishing boats, shops, interesting buildings and the unique view of Pagasitikos Gulf and Pelion mountain, which invites the visitor for walks as well as interesting stops. The walk along to the sea front with its cafes, restaurants and the famous Volos tsipouradika is simply delightful.
